Judith Ann Roland, 78, peacefully passed away on June 6, 2017 at her home in Houston, Texas after a long battle with cancer. Judy was born in Richmond, Indiana on June 17, 1938, to the late Clarence and Ruby (Todd) Riggleman. Judy attended Richmond High School where she met her husband, Duane, of 58 years. Shortly after getting married in February 1959, Judy joined Duane in Frankfort, Germany where he was stationed with the U.S. Army. Their delayed honeymoon – a trip through Germany, Austria and Italy – established their lifelong love of travel. Together Judy and Duane traveled to nearly all 50 states, as well as to more than 30 countries worldwide.

Their first son, Brett Duane, was born in Germany in 1960. Two more sons – Brian Gregory and Eric Lee – followed in 1965 and 1967, respectively. Judy dedicated her life to raising her three sons and ardently supported them in all their school activities from sports to theater to band. Wherever her children were, that's where you'd find Judy.

Judy was active in a variety of civic organizations over the years including Jayshees, Tri Kappa and ABWA. As her sons grew older, she went back to work and together with her sister ran Senior Opportunity Services. She retired from her career as office manager at Whitewater Construction, which she co-owned with her husband Duane.

Judy is survived by her devoted husband, Duane Roland of Houston, TX, her sister, Jeanne Vogelgesang of Louisville, KY; sons Brett Roland and his wife Cathy of Richmond, IN, Brian Roland and his partner Ray of Chicago, IL, and Eric Roland and his partner Steve of Houston, TX; five grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.

Visitation services for Judy Roland will be held at Riggle-Waltermann Mortuary on Saturday, June 10 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm followed immediately by the funeral and private graveside service at Crown Hill Cemetery in Centerville, IN.
